These items **MUST** be recycled by law:

- ◇ TVs**—all types (CRT, flat screen, rear projection, console, etc.) NO CHARGE
****Disassembled/stripped/smashed TVs subject to \$25.00 hazardous waste handling fee****
- ◇ Computer monitors**—all types (CRT, flat screen, LED/LCD) NO CHARGE
- ◇ CPUs/Towers Laptops, iPads, tablets Peripherals (mice, keyboards, speakers) Printers, All-in-One Printers NO CHARGE

Items we collect but are not required by law to be recycled:

- ◇ Answering Machines Cameras Camcorders Cell phones
- ◇ Christmas lights Docking Stations Electric typewriters Electrical Cords
- ◇ Fax/copy machines Gaming consoles Gaming controllers Microwaves
- ◇ Pagers Radios Remote Controls Stereos/tapedecks/CD players
- ◇ Telephone systems Testing equipment VCR/DVD players Video games/cartridges

***SPEAKERS, STEREOS, ETC. MUST BE REMOVED FROM WOOD CABINETS/ENCLOSURES**

Not Accepted (anything that's mostly plastic, glass, or ceramic):

- Ink/toner cartridges Laptop batteries (loose) Small appliances (coffee pots, blenders, mixers, lamps)
- Medical Equipment Pianos, organs Vacuum cleaners, rug scrubbers
